The schedule of workshops is designed to address all of the workforce issues facing workers and employers in Northwestern Ontario. Workshop topics include workplace inclusion, strengthening the Aboriginal workforce, labour adjustment, information technology, the aging workforce, trends and opportunities, essential skills and human resources forecasting.	
Project Outcome:	129 delegates attended the “Taking Action 2004” Forum from across Northwestern Ontario and the evaluations received have been extremely positive – several participants noted that this was an event that was long overdue. Our vision for Taking Action 2004 Workforce Development Forum was simple yet challenging. Could we organize an event that would inform and education people and culminate in the development of action-oriented strategies to address the region’s most pressing workforce issues – the answer – a resounding yes!
